

# Outline of procedures for persons coming from China

For those who return to, come to or enter Japan from China (not limited to Hubei and Zhejiang Provinces) (In principle, short-term invitation of person's from China are to be cancelled.)

※As of 12 am, Feb. 13<sup>th</sup>, 2020: Unless there are exceptional circumstances, those who have travelled to Hubei or Zhejiang Provinces within two weeks of their planned entry or have a passport issued from Hubei or Zhejiang Province will be refused entry to Japan, irregardless of whether or not they have symptoms of the virus.

**Fever (37.5°C or higher) & respiratory condition before or at departure**

Have symptoms

Have no symptoms

**Don't come to Japan**

※Seek medical treatment, etc. at your location

**Can come to Japan**

※Monitor health after arrival

Those already in Japan

**37.5°C or higher fever & respiratory condition occurs within 2 weeks after return to Japan (or after interaction with persons who have visited Hubei/Zhejiang Provinces)**

Have these symptoms

Have no symptoms

**Stay home 14 days after arrival: Monitor your health by checking your temperature, etc.**

If symptoms appear within 2 weeks of arrival

After 2 weeks of residing in Japan with no symptoms

Confirm your health conditions at the Health Care Center

**End of monitoring your health**

**[For those returning from Hubei or Zhejiang Provinces or interacted with persons who have visited these provinces]**

Avoid contact with others, wear mask &, after alerting Health Care Center (0743-72-5108), call Consultation Center for People with Potential Exposure to COVID-19 (0742-27-1132) as soon as possible.

**[For all other cases]**

Avoid contact with others, wear a mask and, after alerting the Health Care Center at 0743-72-5108, and visit a hospital as soon as possible. (Contact in advance to explain your condition)
