Continued adherence to new coronavirus measures through Golden Week holidays

With the continued spreading of the new coronavirus infection (COVID-19), a state of emergency was issued on April 25th for Tokyo, Kyoto, Osaka, and Hyogo Prefectures.

In heading towards the Golden Week holidays, the Director of the Cabinet Secretariat's Coronavirus Infectious Disease Control Promotion Office has notified us through the Higher Education Policy Planning Division, Higher Education Bureau, Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology, to thoroughly announce the information below.

In addition, this declaration of a state of emergency is a strict action to stop the flow of people at once as a short-term intensive measure for Golden Week. If you cannot avoid going to your hometown or traveling, refrain from going to places where there is a high risk of infection, thoroughly implement basic infection prevention measures (hand disinfection, wearing masks, avoiding loud voices, adequate ventilation, etc.), avoid 3 Cs as much as possible, refrain from eating in large groups and beware of spreading infection to the elderly, etc.

Notice (Points to note)

- Given that the number of people infected with mutant strains is increasing, please refrain from unnecessary and unurgent movement across prefectures.
- If you have a fever or other symptoms, please refrain from returning to your hometown.
