(May 8th announcement)

In the Crisis Measures Headquarters meeting held today (May 8th), it was decided that the current limitation level, Level 4 (maximum limitations), for activities at NAIST in the Guide for Limiting Activities at NAIST to Prevent the Spreading of the New Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Infection will be maintained until May 31st, so please continue your awareness of this situation.

The Japanese government is planning to conduct a mid-term evaluation of the effectiveness of measures being taken on May 14th, and we will reconsider and announce the limitation level at NAIST based on the decisions announced by the Japanese government and/or Nara prefecture at that time.
