Measures concerning the new coronavirus (COVID-19) (May 14th announcement)

Taking into account the changing new coronavirus (COVID-19) situation, NAIST has set the measures concerning the new coronavirus (COVID-19) and announced them previously on April 9th. The Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare has revised the "standards for consultation (basic and medical)" for PCR testing and has changed the contents of the April 9th announcement as follows below. Please make sure you are aware of the content changes.

Original April 9th contents

1) In case you or your housemates (family) have fevers below 37.5 °C:

Basically, you may rest at home and keep yourself isolated. Voluntarily refrain from going to work as much as possible.

For treatment, visit a nearby hospital or the NAIST Health Care Center if necessary. You may come to laboratory three days after the fever has gone.

Measure: When you rest at home, you should take annual paid leave or sick leave. Sick leave may only be taken if you have a fever. (The same in all cases below.)

2) In case you or your housemates (family) have fevers of 37.5 °C or higher for 1-3 days:

You should stay at home. You can seek treatment at a medical facility. If the fever subsides in 1-3 days, you shouldn't go to work for 5 days from the day the fever started and three days after the fever is gone.

Measure: You should take annual paid leave or sick leave for the time you are absent.

3) In case you or your housemates (family) <u>have fevers of 37.5 °C or higher for more than 4 days</u> or feel severe fatigue:

Please contact the "Nara Coronavirus Returnee and Exposure Call Center" (0742-27-1132) at the Koriyama Health Division and follow their instructions.

Regardless of the PCR test results, please stay at home for 2 weeks and contact with the Crisis Response Headquarters (somu[at]ad.naist.jp) and the NAIST Health Care Center (nisiyama[at]hcc.naist.jp).

Measure: <u>You should take annual paid leave or sick leave for the first 4 days and compulsory</u> <u>leave will start from the 5th day.</u> For compulsory leave, you will be able to receive salary for up to 90 days. Updated contents

1) In case you or your housemates (family) have fevers below 37.5 °C:

You should stay at home.

You can seek treatment at a medical facility. If the fever subsides in 1-3 days, you shouldn't go to work for 6 days from the day the fever started and three days after the fever is gone.

Also, if your housemate (family) have the same symptoms, measure and record your temperature and health conditions, and, especially in cases of coughing or fever, you should stay at home.

Measure: When you rest at home, you should take annual paid leave or sick leave. Sick leave may only be taken if you have a fever. (The same in all cases below)

2) In case you or your housemates (family) experience strong symptoms such as breathing troubles, extreme fatigue or a high fever:

Measure: You should take annual paid leave or sick leave. <u>Compulsory leave shall begin the</u> <u>day after the PCR test.</u>

For compulsory leave, you will be able to receive salary for up to 90 days.

O Response in cases of fever

1) In case you or your housemates (family) have fevers below 37.5 °C:

You should stay at home.

You can seek treatment at a medical facility. If the fever subsides in 1-3 days, you shouldn't go to work for 6 days from the day the fever started and three days after the fever is gone.

Also, if your housemate (family) have the same symptoms, measure and record your temperature and health conditions, and, especially in cases of coughing or fever, you should stay at home.

Measure: When you rest at home, you should take annual paid leave or sick leave. Sick leave may only be taken if you have a fever. (The same in all cases below)

2) In case you or your housemates (family) experience strong symptoms such as breathing troubles, extreme fatigue or a high fever:

Please contact the "Nara Coronavirus Returnee and Exposure Call Center" (0742-27-1132) at the Koriyama Health Division and follow their instructions.

Regardless of the PCR test results, please stay at home for 2 weeks and contact with the Crisis Response Headquarters (somu[at]ad.naist.jp) and the NAIST Health Care Center (nisiyama[at]hcc.naist.jp).

Measure: You should take annual paid leave or sick leave. Compulsory leave shall begin the day after the PCR test.

For compulsory leave, you will be able to receive salary for up to 90 days.

3) In case you are infected with the new coronavirus (COVID-19)

Please follow the instructions of the public health center, etc. and you will be on compulsory leave until complete recovery. You will be able to receive salary for up to 90 days.

4) In case you are at a high risk of having had contact with a COVID-19 patient

You will be on compulsory leave for the period the public health center, etc. has prescribed to you for quarantine. You will be able to received salary for up to 90 days.
