Measures concerning the new coronavirus (COVID-19) (June 4th announcement)

Concerning the response to the new coronavirus infection at NAIST: With the lifting of the state of

emergency on May 25th for all the prefectures in Japan a transition period has been established with

the assumption that a 'new type of lifestyle' will take over. For this, the calls to refrain from

nonessential outings are being relaxed and levels which restrict the social and industrial activities of

Japan are gradually being lowered as well.

We ask that all the faculty, staff and students read and understand the following requests concerning

domestic travel and entering the campus.

[Domestic travel]

With the Japanese government's request for people who will travel to or through certain Kanto

prefectures or Hokkaido prefecture to be very careful in their travels and activities, we ask all faculty,

staff and students who will travel domestically for business, etc. to be extremely cautious when

considering travelling to or through Saitama, Chiba, Tokyo, Kanagawa and Hokkaido prefectures until

June 18th. We will announce the handling of domestic travel after June 19th at a later date.

(Campus visitors)

There are no specific restrictions for visitors entering the campus, but we would like them to pay

attention to the following:

Make efforts to avoid the 3 Cs (closed spaces, crowded places and close-contact settings) and practice

the basic measures to prevent the spread of infection, beginning with maintaining personal distance,

wearing a mask and hand hygiene.
