Continuation of Japanese Government Border Enforcement Measures

The following measures for border enforcement which have been decided to be in effect until the lifting of the state of emergency will remain in effect for the time being.

- (1) Temporary suspension of "Business Track" and "Residence Track"
- (2) Temporary suspension of new entry into Japan from all countries and regions
- (3) Temporary suspension of exceptional measures for returnees and re-entrants to Japan after short-term business travels to all countries and regions

The measures for border enforcement are reviewed and reviewed daily, therefore, any persons who plan to accept visitors from abroad or travel abroad need to confirm the information on the Ministry of Foreign Affairs website and check the latest information from Japanese Embassy for your destination.
