To all faculty, staff and students

Food support measures concerning people required to stay at home
due to the new coronavirus (2019 - nCov)

In dealing with the possible spreading of the new coronavirus, faculty staff and students (including family members, etc.) who have returned to Japan from China, regardless of whether they have any symptoms or not, are to remain home for two weeks from the day that they arrived back in Japan. In these cases, NAIST has decided to assist those told to stay home financially for their food during the period stipulated by NAIST. If you are eligible for this support and would like to receive it, please contact the Crisis Measures Headquarters. (General Affairs Section of the Planning and General Affairs Division)

Those who contact the Crisis Measures Headquarters will receive details about the support and ordering, after the people's eligibility is confirmed.

○Those eligible for support

- (1) People required to stay home for 2 weeks after arriving back to Japan from China (including Hong Kong and Macao)
- (2) Those people living with people in (1) above
- (3) Others deemed necessary by the Head of the Crisis Measures Headquarters

○Range of support

Packed meals and other services will be announced and eligible people will order and pay for the food, etc. individually. After the stay-at-home period has ended, NAIST will reimburse the costs incurred (within the support amount), calculated from the receipts submitted.

○Support amount

Up to 3,500 Yen per person per day (Delivery charges may also be reimbursed.)

○Note

When receiving foods, etc., make sure to wear a mask. (Handed out separately)
