Notice to continue adherence to new coronavirus infection prevention measures

While the current trend in new coronavirus infection cases is showing a reduction in new cases, the state of emergency announced for various prefectures continue, as there is still causing a strain on the medical system in Japan. With this in mind, we would like to ask everyone to continue to pay attention to the following points while maintaining a sense of “protecting yourself” in your actions.

Additionally, becoming infected by the new coronavirus may happen to anyone. We ask that you refrain from actions such as slander, etc. or the irresponsible spreading of information via the internet.

Points to note for infection prevention

- Take thorough measures to prevent the spread of infection (Washing or disinfecting hands, wearing masks, coughing etiquette, etc.)
- Continued avoidance of areas where the 3 Cs (closed spaces, crowded places and close-contact settings) may occur
- Measure your temperature upon entering buildings and wash or disinfect your hands before continuing to your destination
- Make sure to open the windows and ventilate regularly indoors in the labs, classrooms, etc.
- When eating or drinking, avoid large numbers of people and do not stay long
- When eating or drinking, refrain from conversation, social distance, and do not sit next to or directly across from others
- Refrain from non-essential outings
