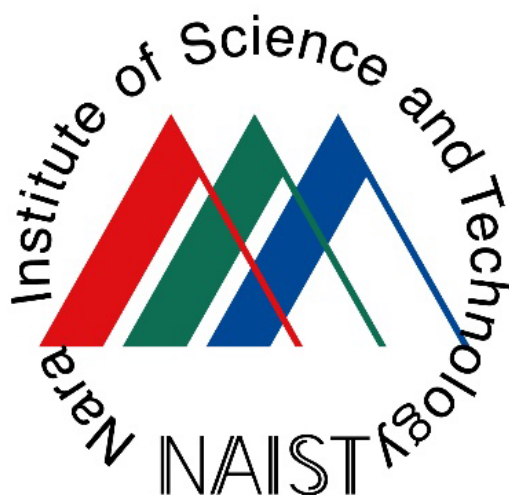

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NAIST Education Policy

● Objectives

As a graduate institution without undergraduate courses, NAIST promotes cutting-edge research and offers a sophisticated outcome-based education for each student so as to contribute to the advancement of science and technology and of society as a whole.

● Educational mission

NAIST was founded in October 1991 as a graduate institution which educates individuals who will contribute to the development of advanced science and technology. Research and education at NAIST cover the three core areas: information science, biological science and materials science.

In order to realize a suitable standard of living for people throughout the world in the 21st century, and indeed to secure our very survival, the coming generation of leading researchers must possess the highest scientific and technical competence, along with a clear grounding in professional ethics. At NAIST, we aim to cultivate such researchers and educators.

Therefore, in addition to the areas of information science, biological science and materials science, we actively encourage interdisciplinary research and provide educational training in the principles of ethics and intellectual property.

● Objectives for student development

Education and research in NAIST master's course cultivate sophisticated expertise and personal initiative to support society and the economy. The doctoral courses are designed to nurture students to become researchers and engineers with the drive to seek new frontiers in science and technology and to take on leading roles internationally.

● Educational policy

In addition to a specialized education, the wide-ranging curriculum cultivates ethical thinking, vision, theoretical thinking, comprehensive judgment and sharpened writing skills.

Educational programs to produce human resources who will pursue new interdisciplinary research fields are executed and those to produce human resources with a thorough, globally-focused understanding, which include collaborative programs with our overseas education and research partners, are offered.

Internal and external evaluations are implemented to continuously improve the quality of education, while enrichment of the education and research environments and the financial support for talented students are being promoted.

NAIST Admission Policy

● Prospective students

We are looking for students, researchers or engineers who have fundamental academic skills, a clear vision, a resolve toward the future, and a strong interest in and motivation for advanced science and technology, regardless of their background or undergraduate major. Especially, we actively accept applicants who have the ability to reason logically and accurately express their thoughts, and those who are very inquisitive and have the ability to tackle challenges.

● Basic admissions policy

In order to select outstanding persons with the above qualifications both domestically and abroad, we stress assessment of applicants' character and capability. There are various routes for admission, including examinations centered upon interviews as well as examinations based on recommendations.

2. Requirements for Application

Applicants who fulfill all of the following conditions can apply:

- (1) Those who do not hold Japanese nationality.
- (2) Those who are recommended by the president or dean of a university or research institution with which NAIST has concluded an Academic Exchange Agreement (see the URL below), and who are recognized for their excellence in academics, achievement, personality and character.

In accordance with the above, candidates must meet one of the criteria below:

A: Those who are registered as students, faculty members or researchers at the universities or research institution on the list.

B: Those who have graduated from a university or research institution on the list.

- (3) Regarding the bachelor's degree, applicants should meet one of the following conditions.

A: Those who have completed or will complete a 16-year curriculum of school education in foreign countries by March 31, 2026*.

B: Those who was conferred or will be conferred the equivalent of a bachelor's degree by March 31, 2026* by completing the course that the years required for graduation are 3 years or more in foreign university or other foreign schools deemed eligible by the Minister of MEXT.

C: Those who are recognized by NAIST through the Preliminary Evaluation for Suitability to have the academic ability equivalent or superior to the level of a bachelor's degree, and who will be 22 years of age or older by March 31, 2026*.

Note: Applicants who wish to apply based on qualification (3)-C should follow the procedures given in item 11: Preliminary Evaluation of Applicant Suitability before taking the screening

*For Fall Admission these dates change to September 30, 2026.

4. Online Application System Registration

Applicants must register their applications online.

(1) Screening (Examination) fee

Screening (Examination) fee is 30,000 yen.

To complete registration, applicants must complete the payment of the screening (examination) fee.

Please choose one of the methods from ①～④ listed below, and pay the screening (examination) fee.

Japanese government (Monbukagakusho: MEXT) Scholarship Students are exempt from the screening (examination) fee.

MEXT Scholarship Students enrolled at universities other than NAIST, must submit a certificate stating their status as MEXT Scholarship Students.

Research Proposal	<p>Please write a two-page paper on A4-size paper that covers the following topics: “The contents of my undergraduate studies” and “The research field/project that I want to work on at NAIST.” (Any format is acceptable, however, please upload the document in PDF format.)</p> <p>It must be more than one page and no more than two pages for both topics together.</p> <p>Please upload the document in PDF format.</p> <p>[Important Notes]</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 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(3) Others

- The status appearing on the Online Application System will be updated approximately 1 week after the respective application period. Please be sure to confirm that your status has changed to “Applied”.
- If you pass the screening, you are required to submit the original hard copy of “Graduation certificate (degree certificate)” (in paper form) and “Transcript” (in paper form) in the enrollment procedures.
- If your home university does not issue paper certificates, digital certificates are accepted in the enrollment procedures on the condition that the following 1 and 2 are attached.
 - 1) URL of an online verification service that can verify the authenticity of the digital certificates
 - 2) URL of the issuer’s official web page indicating that the issuer is using such an online verification service

5. Download Screening (Examination) Voucher

Please download the screening (Examination) Voucher from the Online Application System. An e-mail will be sent to the address

registered in the Online Application System once the document is ready.

*The term “Examination” will be used on the webpage in place of “Screening”.

6. Important Application Notes

- If the applicant has a physical disability and requires special assistance in taking examinations, screening, or in following the standard academic program, please consult with the Admissions Section of the Educational Affairs Division at least three months prior to applying. Contact within three months of the application period is permitted, however, please understand we may not be able to accommodate your request. Please prepare a copy of a disability certificate and a doctor's certificate as you will be asked to submit these in due course.

- In principle, if the application documents are incomplete, the application will not be accepted. Further changes to the submitted documents will not be accepted.
- Applicants may be deemed to have committed a fraudulent act if they falsify, fabricate or plagiarize a document, materials or information included in their application. In such cases, any decisions made based upon the application and materials may be invalidated at a later date. If your entrance to NAIST is cancelled, your application, documents and screening (examination) fee may not be returned.

7. Screening Method

Applicants are evaluated according to a screening of application documents.

However, a speaking assessment may be conducted in addition if deemed necessary. In that case, you will be notified separately of the date and place of the speaking assessment.

9. Payments Required for Admission

- (1) Enrollment fee: 282,000 yen (Provisional)
- (2) Tuition fee: 267,900 yen per semester. (535,800 yen for the annual fee) (Provisional)

If there is a change in fees, the new admission and tuition fees will apply to all students who will enter NAIST after the change.

10. Preliminary Evaluation of Applicant Suitability

Those who wish to apply under Requirement for Application (3)-C (p.1) must first pass the Preliminary Evaluation for Applicant Suitability before formally applying.
