

IIBC to Offer Digital Official Score Certificate for TOEIC® Program Tests

The Institute of International Business Communication (IIBC), which administers and operates the TOEIC® Program in Japan, has announced that has begun providing Digital Official Score Certificates for the TOEIC® Program test in April 2023. In response to this announcement, NAIST will accept the submission of the Digital Official Score Certificate as a new method of submitting TOEIC scores for the NAIST Entrance Examination to be conducted in the academic year 2023.

The method of submission and the applicable entrance examinations are as follows. The existing paper-based Official Score Certificate will continue to be accepted.

<Submission Method>

1. Download the PDF data of the Digital Official Score Certificate from the TOEIC application website.
2. Upload the PDF data of the Digital Official Score Certificate to the online application system.
3. Enter the URL which NAIST can check your Digital Official Score Certificate to the online application system.
4. Enclose a printed copy of the Digital Official Score Certificate with the other application documents and send them by post to NAIST by the day following the last day of the application period (postmarked at Japan Standard Time).

<Examinations for which digital certificates may be submitted>

- Master's Course: 1st-3rd Exam for Spring 2024 Admission
- Master's Course: 1st Exam for Fall 2024 Admission
- Master's Course: 2nd Exam for Fall 2023 Admission
- Doctoral Course: 1st-2nd Exam for Spring 2024 Admission
- Doctoral Course: 1st Exam for Fall 2024 Admission
- Doctoral Course: 2nd Exam for Fall 2023 Admission
